



Incapacity Benefit by Parliamentary Constituency

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This note contains figures for the number of people claiming Incapacity Benefit and Severe Disablement Allowance in each constituency in February 2009. These are compared with the working age population reported in the 2001 Census of Population.

In February 2009 there were 2.5 million claimants of Incapacity Benefit and Severe Disablement Allowance in Great Britain. This is 7% of the working age population at the time of the 2001 Census of Population. Incapacity Benefit claimants are relatively concentrated in a few areas. The 20% of constituencies with the highest incidence of ICB/SDA account for 30% of the total ICB/SDA claimants in Great Britain.

In 16 of the 628 GB parliamentary constituencies, claimants of incapacity benefit represent 15% or more of the working age population.

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A. Incapacity Benefit and Severe Disablement Allowance

Incapacity Benefit was introduced in April 1995 to replace Sickness Benefit and Invalidity Benefit. It is a weekly benefit paid to those who are incapable of work because of illness or disability. From April 2006, it is paid at three basic rates:

- The short-term lower rate for the first 28 weeks of incapacity (£63.75 pw)
- The short-term higher rate from 29-52 weeks of incapacity (£75.40 pw)
- The long-term rate after 52 weeks (£84.50 pw)

Until 6 April 2001 entitlement for new claimants was based on National Insurance contributions. From that date, it is still a contributory benefit for most people, but there are exemptions from the contribution conditions for those who are incapacitated early in life.

Long-term Incapacity Benefit is not payable after pension age (60 for a woman, 65 for a man). The Welfare Reform and Pensions Act 1999 made changes to various aspects of Incapacity Benefit. This included the abolition of Severe Disablement Allowance for new claimants from 6 April 2001. Instead some new claimants who would previously have qualified for Severe Disablement Allowance became entitled to Incapacity Benefit instead. Existing SDA claimants were unaffected. These changes are described in more detail in Library Standard Note 791¹

B. Constituency data

The DWP produces quarterly figures for the numbers claiming and receiving Incapacity Benefit. These are available via the DWP website, which contains a tabulation tool² enabling users to specify the data tables they require. The options include extracting data for parliamentary constituency areas³. To prevent details about individuals being revealed, these figures are rounded to the nearest 100. The rankings in this note are based on the unrounded ratio of these benefit data to the working age population in 2001. Where two areas have a similar ratio, the relative position of one constituency to another may be due to this rounding rather than any significant difference in the incidence of ICB/SDA.

Data for the working age population is from the 2001 Census. The figures are for the population aged 16 to 59, plus men aged 60 to 64.

In February 2009 there were 2.5 million claimants of Incapacity Benefit and Severe Disablement Allowance in Great Britain. This is 7% of the working age population at the time of the 2001 Census of Population. Figures for individual parliamentary constituencies show considerable variation with some areas having much higher than average rates of claiming ICB/SDA. Constituencies in areas where employment was dependent on heavy industry and mining and where unemployment is relatively high tend also to have above-average rates of claiming ICB/SDA. The 20% of constituencies with the highest incidence of ICB/SDA account for 30% of the total ICB/SDA claimants in Great Britain.
