A. Technical notes

- Data are drawn from the uncorrected daily *Hansard*.
- The Speaker and his three deputies, who do not normally vote, are included in Did Not Vote (DNV) columns, as are the four Sinn Fein MPs who have not taken their seats.
- As there is no provision in the House of Commons for a formal abstention, a member wishing to vote neither for nor against a motion is recorded as not voting, along with those who did not vote for other reasons.
- In the calculation of percentages, Aye Tellers are included in the Ayes and No Tellers in the Noes.
- Percentages shown may not sum to 100% due to rounding. In addition, one MP voted both Aye and No in division 96.

B. Divisions 96 and 97: 26 February 2003

The government motion was as follows:¹

That this House takes note of Command Paper Cm 5769 on Iraq; reaffirms its endorsement of United Nations Security Council Resolution 1441, as expressed in its Resolution of 25th November 2002; supports the Government's continuing efforts in the United Nations to disarm Iraq of its weapons of mass destruction; and calls upon Iraq to recognise this as its final opportunity to comply with its disarmament obligations.

The amendment selected, tabled in the name of Rt Hon Chris Smith MP, was as follows:²

To leave out from "destruction" to end and add

"but finds the case for military action against Iraq as yet unproven."

The amendment was the subject of division 96; the government motion division 97. The divisions are analysed in turn below.

- The amendment was defeated by 194 votes.
- Over one-third of MPs who participated did so in favour of the amendment, including 122 Labour members and 14 Conservatives.
- Had the Conservatives who voted No abstained, the Noes would have had a majority of 65. Had they voted in favour of the amendment, it would have been passed with a majority of 64.

- The government motion was passed with a majority of 310.
- One-third of the Parliamentary Labour Party either participated against the government motion or did not vote.
- Had the Conservatives who voted Aye abstained, the government would have had a majority of 158. Had all 164 Conservatives voted against, the government motion would have been defeated.

A total of 392 MPs voted against the amendment and then for the government motion. 253 of those were Labour MPs, amounting to 61 percent of the parliamentary party.

23 members, comprising 13 Labour and 10 Conservatives, voted for both the amendment *and* the government motion.

C. Divisions 117 and 118: 18 March 2003

The government motion was as follows:³

That this House notes its decisions of 25th November 2002 and 26th February 2003 to endorse UN Security Council Resolution 1441; recognises that Iraq's weapons of mass destruction and long range missiles, and its continuing non-compliance with Security Council Resolutions, pose a threat to international peace and security; notes that in the 130 days since Resolution 1441 was adopted Iraq has not co-operated actively, unconditionally and immediately with the weapons inspectors, and has rejected the final opportunity to comply and is in further material breach of its obligations under successive mandatory UN Security Council Resolutions; regrets that despite sustained diplomatic effort by Her Majesty's Government it has not proved possible to secure a second Resolution in the UN because one Permanent Member of the Security Council made plain in public its intention to use its veto whatever the circumstances; notes the opinion of the Attorney General that, Iraq having failed to comply and Iraq being at the time of Resolution 1441 and continuing to be in material breach, the authority to use force under Resolution 678 has revived

and so continues today; believes that the United Kingdom must uphold the authority of the United Nations as set out in Resolution 1441 and many Resolutions preceding it, and therefore supports the decision of Her Majesty's Government that the United Kingdom should use all means necessary to ensure the disarmament of Iraq's weapons of mass destruction; offers wholehearted support to the men and women of Her Majesty's Armed Forces now on duty in the Middle East; in the event of military operations requires that, on an urgent basis, the United Kingdom should seek a new Security Council Resolution that would affirm Iraq's territorial integrity, ensure rapid delivery of humanitarian relief, allow for the earliest possible lifting of UN sanctions, an international reconstruction programme, and the use of all oil revenues for the benefit of the Iraqi people and endorse an appropriate post-conflict administration for Iraq, leading to a representative government which upholds human rights and the rule of law for all Iraqis; and also welcomes the imminent publication of the Quartet's roadmap as a significant step to bringing a just and lasting peace settlement between Israelis and Palestinians and for the wider Middle East region, and endorses the role of Her Majesty's Government in actively working for peace between Israel and Palestine.

The amendment selected, tabled in the name of Rt Hon Chris Smith MP, was as follows:⁴

To leave out from "1441" in line 2, to "in" in line 21 and insert—

"believes that the case for war against Iraq has not yet been established, especially given the absence of specific United Nations authorisation; but, in the event that hostilities do commence, pledges its total support for the British forces engaged in the Middle East, expresses its admiration for their courage, skill and devotion to duty, and hopes that their tasks will be swiftly concluded with minimal casualties on all sides."

The amendment was the subject of division 117; the government motion division 118. The divisions are analysed in turn below.

- The amendment was defeated by 179 votes.

- Over one third of the Parliamentary Labour Party participated in favour of the amendment.
- Had all 164 Conservatives voted in favour of the amendment, it would have been passed by 109 votes.

- The government motion was passed with a majority of 263.
- One-fifth of the Parliamentary Labour Party voted against the government. Around three-fifths supported the government motion.
- 52 more MPs did not vote in division 118 than in division 117.

Of the 217 MPs that voted for the amendment in division 117, 9 voted for the government motion, 60 did not vote, and 148 voted against the government.

10 MPs who did not vote in division 117 supported the government motion in division 118.

Drawing on data from both dates:

- 22 MPs voted for the amendment on 18 March having voted against the amendment on 26 February. 4 voted against the 18 March amendment having previously voted for the 26 February amendment.
- Over all 4 divisions, 354 MPs consistently followed the government line. Of those, 218 were Labour members, amounting to 53 percent of the parliamentary party.
