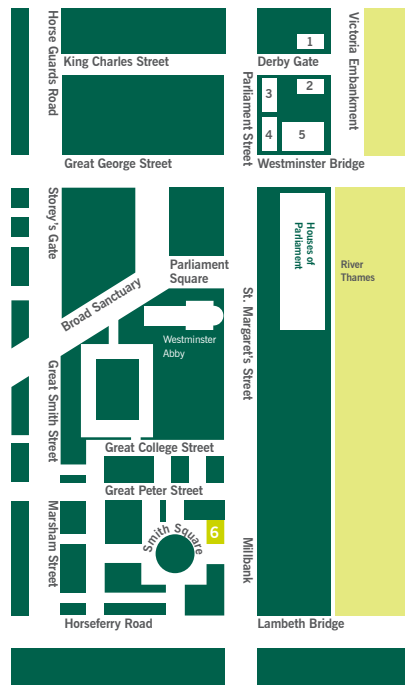

Member's Salary

from 1 April 2007 **£60,675 per year**

Select Committee Chairman's Salary

from 1 April 2007 **£13,459 per year**

Members of the Chairmen's Panel

from 1 April 2007 **up to £13,459 per year**

Member's Pension

Final salary pension

Member's contribution 6% or 10% of salary

Incidental Expenses Provision

to meet the costs of accommodation for office or surgery, work commissioned or other services and certain travel and allowances **£21,339 per year**

Staffing Allowance

to enable Members to employ staff **£90,505 per year**

Additional Costs Allowance

to reimburse Members for costs incurred when staying overnight away from their main home whilst performing Parliamentary duties **£23,083 per year**

London Supplement

(certain Members only) **£2,812 per year**

Communication Allowance

to assist Members with pro-active communications **£10,000 per year**

Travel

Travel for Members

while on Parliamentary business in the UK **unlimited**

Motor Mileage

first 10,000 miles per year at the rate of **40p per mile**
over 10,000 miles at the rate of **25p per mile**

Motorcycles

24p per mile

Bicycles

20p per mile

Travel for the Member's spouse, civil partner and children

up to 15 designated return journeys each year

European Travel

a total of 3 visits per year to:

- EU institutions
- EU Agencies
- The National Parliaments of EU member states and European Free Trade Association states, and of candidate or applicant countries, and of full Members of the Council of Europe

Other Allowances

In addition, Members are entitled to:

- the loan of centrally provided **computer equipment**, for Parliamentary use only
- additional equipment, facilities and assistance if they have a **disability**
- certain **training** for their employees
- additional contributions to **security costs**
- certain centrally provided **insurance**
- a **resettlement grant** payable to Members who leave the House at a general election
- a **winding-up allowance** payable to defeated or retiring Members or representatives of deceased Members after the date on which they cease to be a Member of Parliament

Members' Staff Pension **Group Stakeholder Arrangement**

Travel for Members' Staff **up to 12 designated return journeys each year**
shared between all employees of a Member
