Request for follow-up evidence

Following material published in the UK *Guardian*, *The New York Times* and Channel 4 over the past few days, the Committee would like to request that you supply further evidence.

As I said in my press statement of 18 March, there are a number of inconsistencies in your evidence to us of 27 February, notably your denial that your company received data from the Global Science Research company. We are also interested in asking you again about your claim that you “do not work with Facebook data, and [...] do not have Facebook data.”

You agreed at the 27 February session to send a series of further follow-up answers; we have not received these. We call on you to answer them now.

Giving false statements to a Select Committee is a very serious matter. We urge you to come forward and explain your comments at a Committee hearing.

We would like to receive your response to this letter by Tuesday 27 March.
