

Note on Simon Cope's trip to La Toussuire in June 2011

British Cycling has been asked to supply the select committee with information relating to an ongoing UK Anti-Doping (UKAD) investigation into wrongdoing in cycling, specifically relating to a trip made by Great Britain Cycling Team coach Simon Cope to La Toussuire in June 2011.

British Cycling has been thanked by UKAD for its support of the investigation and throughout the process we have regularly sought instruction from UKAD to see if there are further steps we can undertake.

To fully investigate this matter now would require British Cycling to access documents and information currently locked down by UKAD investigators. Further this would also require British Cycling to interview members of staff and other individuals subject to the investigation which would be contrary to UKAD's instruction.

However, to acknowledge evidence given to the select committee and to share our understanding which we were able to establish before the UKAD investigation began, without compromising the investigation, we know Simon Cope travelled to La Toussuire in June 2011 with a medical package which we understand to be Flumucil for Team Sky. All matters relating to this medical product within the inquiry are now subject to the on-going investigation by UKAD which we hope will report soon.
