

Investigatory Powers Bill

Analysis of the application of Standing Order 830 in respect of Lords amendments

1. For the purposes of the Commons Consideration of Lords Amendments on 1 November 2016, the following is the Department's assessment of the application of Standing Order No. 830 (of the Standing Orders of the House of Commons relating to public business) in respect of the Lords amendments.
2. The Bill applies to the whole of the United Kingdom, subject to the exception that amendments, repeals and revocations have the same extent as the enactment to which they relate. This position has not been changed by any of the Lords amendments. There are no Lords amendments which relate exclusively to England or to England and Wales.
3. As there are no Lords amendments which apply exclusively to England or to England and Wales it is not necessary, for the purposes of the application of Standing Order 830, to consider whether any amended provisions have minor or consequential effects outside England and Wales, or whether any amended provisions would be within the competence of any of the devolved legislatures.
