Mr Speaker's provisional certificate (SO No. 83L) as at 8 May 2018

Under the provisions of Standing Order No. 83L, the Speaker must, after the conclusion of Report stage on any Government bill that has been amended since Second Reading, reconsider the Bill for certification. To assist Members, the Speaker has issued a provisional certificate in advance of Report stage. This takes account of changes made to the Bill in Public Bill Committee and Government amendments (but no others) tabled for consideration at Report stage.
