### **Programme: Domestic Gas and Electricity (Tariff Cap) Bill**

The provisional programme of witnesses for the Domestic Gas and Electricity (Tariff Cap) Bill Committee has been agreed by its Programming Sub-Committee. The Committee will begin its line-by-line scrutiny of the Bill in the afternoon of 13 March, and further consider the Bill on 15 March.
