Local elections 2004

This paper summarises the results of the local elections held in England and Wales on 10 June 2004. It includes ward-by-ward details of the performance of the British National Party. Data regarding turnout in all-postal ballot areas will be added when available.

Labour suffered net losses of over 450 seats and control of 8 councils. The Conservatives made net gains of almost 300 seats and 13 councils, while the Liberal Democrats made net gains of over 100 seats but a net loss of 2 councils.

The results of the mayoral and GLA elections in London held on the same day are summarised in Research Paper 04/48.

The results of the European Parliament elections, held on 10-13 June 2004, are summarised in Research Paper 04/50.

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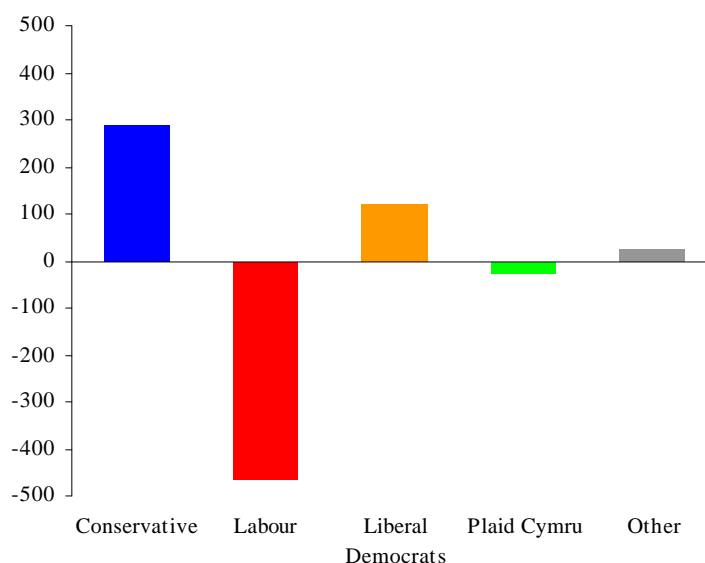
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Summary of main points

- On 10 June 2004, local elections were held in 166 local authorities in England and Wales.
- Labour made net losses of over 450 seats and control of 8 councils. They did, however, win over 500 more seats than the Conservatives and 1,000 more than the Liberal Democrats.
- The Conservatives made net gains of almost 300 seats and 13 councils. Their gains included the metropolitan boroughs of Dudley, Trafford and Walsall.
- The Liberal Democrats gained over 100 seats and gained Newcastle-upon-Tyne and Pendle councils. However, they lost control of 4 other councils.
- Plaid Cymru suffered net losses of 28 seats, 14 percent of their pre-election total. The Green Party won 24 council seats, a net increase of 9. The British National Party won 14 seats, a net increase of 4 increasing their national total to 21. The United Kingdom Independence Party won 3 seats.
- Estimates suggest that the Conservatives won approximately 37 percent of the national equivalent vote, compared to 27 percent for the Liberal Democrats and 26 percent for Labour.
- Local authorities in the North East, North West, Yorkshire and The Humber and East Midlands conducted all postal ballots. Turnout was higher than at previous recent local elections in both areas with and without such polls.

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I Introduction

On 10 June 2004, elections were held in the following local authorities:

- The whole of 36 metropolitan district councils.
- The whole of the council in 9 English unitary authorities and the one-third of the council in a further 10.
- The whole of 14 shire district councils, half of the council in 6, and one-third of the council in a further 69.
- The whole of 22 unitary authorities in Wales.

This paper is intended as a brief and immediate summary of the local elections and is largely based on media reports and data supplied by local authorities.¹ The final compilation of the results, including details of votes cast, shares of the vote and turnout, inevitably takes some time. These will be published later in the year.²

There have been changes to boundaries and councillor numbers in many areas. Seat gains and losses shown are simply comparisons with the situation before the elections and therefore do not necessarily sum to zero.

II The results

A. Council control

- The Conservatives now control 51 of the councils which held elections, compared to 39 Labour and nine Liberal Democrat.
- The Conservatives gained 13 councils, including Thurrock and Tamworth from Labour and Eastbourne from the Liberal Democrats. They gained a further 10 from no overall control, including the metropolitan borough councils of Dudley, Trafford and Walsall.
- Labour lost 8 councils in net terms, despite gaining 2 from Plaid Cymru and 5 from no overall control. Their 15 losses included the metropolitan boroughs of Doncaster and St Helens (to no overall control) and Newcastle-upon-Tyne (to the Liberal Democrats).
- The Liberal Democrats won Newcastle-upon-Tyne and Pendle but lost control of 4 councils, including Eastbourne to the Conservatives.

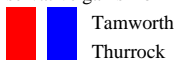
- Plaid Cymru lost 2 of their three councils to Labour. They now only hold Gwynedd.
- The Residents' Association held Elmbridge council. Independents remain in the majority in Anglesey, Pembrokeshire and Powys.

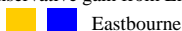

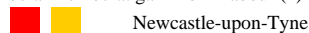

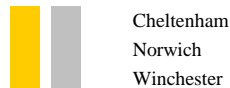

B. Council seats

- The Conservatives won 1,700 seats, 28 percent of the total and a net gain of almost 300 councillors. They won 69 percent of seats on councils controlled by Conservatives pre-election, compared to 15 percent in councils controlled by Labour and 12 percent in councils controlled by the Liberal Democrats. Despite overall seat gains, the Conservatives still do not have any seats on several metropolitan borough councils, including Manchester, Liverpool or Newcastle-upon-Tyne.
- Labour won almost 2,300 seats, 37 percent of the total and a net fall of over 450. Their performance appears to have been better in the West Midlands than in other regions. Labour lost well over 200 councillors in metropolitan borough areas in net terms, despite winning almost half of the seats on offer. They tended to fare worst in areas where they controlled the council pre-elections.
- The Liberal Democrats won almost 1,300 seats, 21 percent of the total and a net gain of over 100. In net terms they gained seats on councils held pre-election by Labour but lost seats in councils held by the other parties. They won more seats than the Conservatives in both the North East and North West regions.
- Plaid Cymru lost 28 seats in net terms, 14 percent of their pre-election total. The Green Party won 24 council seats, a net increase of 9. The British National Party won 14 seats while the United Kingdom Independence Party won three.

Two appendix tables are attached:

Appendix 1 summarises numbers of seats won, and gained and lost in net terms, by party, type of authority, region, the proportion of seats up for election, pre-election council controlling party and type of ballot.

Appendix 2 details full local election results on a council-by-council basis. It includes council control, seats won, net seat gains and losses and post-election council control. An asterisk indicates that the area has been subject to ward boundary changes while a hash mark signifies an all-postal ballot.

C. National equivalent share of the vote

Estimates suggest that the Conservatives won around 37 percent of the national equivalent vote, compared to 27 percent Liberal Democrat and 26 percent Labour.³

The table below shows trends in the estimated national equivalent share of the vote at local elections since 1979. Labour polled their lowest national equivalent share on record in 2004, the lowest by a governing party since 1995, and came third. The Liberal Democrats came second on this measure for the first time. The Conservatives estimated national equivalent share in 2004 was 5 percentage points higher than that at the 2001 general election but lower than that estimated from the 2000 local elections.

D. Post-election council composition

The table overleaf summarises post-election council composition across Great Britain.

- The Conservatives hold over 8,000 council seats across Great Britain, 37 percent of the total and more than any other party. They hold 46 percent of seats in shire district and county areas, compared to 22 percent in metropolitan borough areas where they are the third largest party overall.

- Labour hold approximately 6,700 seats in Great Britain, 30 percent of the total. They are the largest party in metropolitan boroughs, London boroughs and English, Welsh and Scottish unitary authorities. In shire districts, however, they are the third largest party.
- The Liberal Democrats hold around 4,700 seats, 21 percent of the total. Of types of authority, they are now strongest in English unitary authority areas.

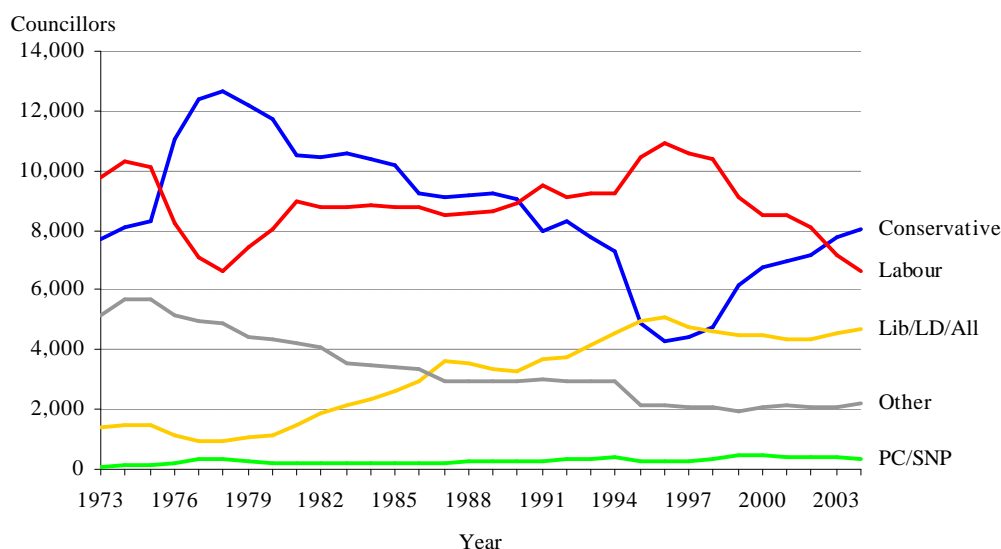

The chart below shows trends in post-election numbers of councillors by party since local government was reorganised in 1973. Note that the total number of councillors has fallen by around 3,800 since the peak of almost 26,000 in the mid-1970s.

Party affiliation of councillors: 1973-2004



- The Conservatives hold 8,000 council seats for the first time since 1992, having briefly been third in terms of numbers of councillors in the mid-1990s.
- The number of Labour councillors has fallen each year since 1996. They have less than 7,000 councillors for the first time since 1978.
- The Liberal Democrats have more councillors than in any year since 1997.

III Performance of the British National Party

The BNP fielded a total of 309 candidates in 59 local authorities in England and Wales, and won a total of 14 seats, a net gain of 4, and leaving them with a total of 21. In the seats they contested they averaged 16.1 percent of the vote.

Note: The BNP won a by-election in the ward of Mill Hill in Blackburn with Darwen in November 2002. Robin Evans subsequently resigned from the party and described himself as an Independent. He stood, but lost, on 10 June. The BNP stood against him and came third, failing to win a seat.


