Waiving of financial privilege

Note: in the totals, for example “waived in 35 of 110”, the 110 is the total number of LAs received, whether having financial implications or not. The numbers “disagreed to” show the number of LAs where financial privilege was (automatically) not waived because LAs were disagreed to.

Reasons are shown only where LAs were disagreed to *without an alternative proposition given to the Lords*, because in those circumstances there is no “straight disagreement” and no Reasons are necessary.
