

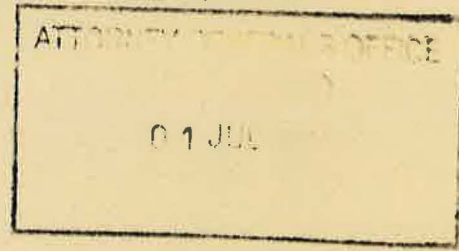

Legal issues regarding the UK's exit from the EU

The Foreign Affairs Committee will shortly be launching a rolling inquiry into the implications of the vote to leave the EU and the Government's management of the exit process. In order to inform this inquiry, the Committee would appreciate your views on the following two legal questions:

1. Can all of the directly-applicable Regulations that currently apply to the UK be transposed into UK law in a single Act of Parliament, should Parliament wish to retain them?
2. On what terms will the UK and EU trade at the end of the two-year negotiating period mandated by Article 50 of the Lisbon Treaty, if:
 - a. No deal has been agreed between the UK and EU on the terms of the UK's exit from the EU; and/or
 - b. No deal has been agreed on the terms of the future relationship between the UK and the EU.

The Committee would be grateful if you could reply by Wednesday 13 July.
