

## Legislation – General Notes

In the list of Bills which follows, the type of Bill is shown at the left-hand margin next to the title by the following codes:

<b>T</b>	Private Members' Bills (Presentation bill under the Ten Minute Rule, <a href="#">SO No 23</a> )

<b>[HL]</b>	Bill starting in the House of Lords
