



Making a complaint to the House of Lords Commissioner for Standards

Complaints alleging breaches of the House of Lords Code of Conduct may be made in writing or by email. This form is intended to help those wishing to submit a complaint. Please download the form before completing it.

The Commissioner recommends that complaints of **bullying, harassment** or **sexual misconduct** be made via the following dedicated helpline who can provide specialist support and advice. However, complaints may also be made directly to the Commissioner.

In the interests of natural justice, the specific allegation made to the Commissioner or the bullying and harassment and sexual misconduct helpline should be made in private and not publicised until the complaint has been finally determined.

The Commissioner will not without good reason consider either anonymous complaints or ones where the complainant is not prepared to have their name and complaint disclosed to the member whose conduct is criticised.
