In May 2020 the House of Lords set up the Life Beyond Covid Committee.



The Committee asked thousands of people what they think things will be like or should be like in 2 to 5 years’ time after the Covid-19 virus.



## The top 5 things people said they think will happen:



There will be more poverty and some people will not have enough money to live on.



People will spend more time online on computers and mobile phones.



Life will not be very good for children and young people.



There will not be as many jobs and more people will work from home.



There will be long-lasting mental health and happiness problems.



**The top 3 things people said they hope will happen:**



More work done to help the planet and the people.



Buildings where people live and work to be better with more access to green spaces.



Caring more about care.



People also told the Committee that even though things had been hard they liked to slow down and spend more time with their families.



Some people were worried about health and being lonely.

The Committee will look at the top things people said so that they can help the Government to decide what to do.



Then they will look at the other things that people said about being healthy and being lonely.
