Dear President Juncker,

you have received a letter on food waste from Lord Boswell of Aynho, Chairman of the House of Lords European Union Committee, dated 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2015 and co-signed by 16 chairpersons of European Union committees of national parliaments. The joint letter recommends steps to be taken by the Commission towards prevention and reduction of food waste.

I would like to draw your attention to the Senate Resolution attached to this letter, in which the Senate supports the joint letter and subscribes to it.
