



Liberal Democrat Hereditary Peers' By-election, January 2005: Result

In the by-election to replace the late Earl Russell, all four of the eligible Liberal Democrat hereditary peers cast valid votes. The successful candidate was **the Earl of Glasgow**, who received all four first-preference votes.

The full list of candidates was as follows:

- E. Glasgow
- L. Kennet

Four Liberal Democrat hereditary peers (L. Addington, L. Avebury, V. Falkland and L. Methuen) were eligible to vote.
