Birmingham Commonwealth Games Bill [HL]	Carried over from previous session. 16/10/19: Pursuant to resolution of 9/9/19, SO 46 dispensed with to enable the bill to be taken pro forma through the stages which it had completed in the previous session. The bill was then read a second time, committed and reported from a Committee of the Whole House and the report received pro forma.
Early Parliamentary General Election Bill	30/10/19: SOs 46 and 48 dispensed with to allow the Bill to be taken through its remaining stages that day and to allow manuscript amendments to be tabled and moved on Third Reading.
High Speed Rail (West Midlands - Crewe) Bill – Hybrid Bill	Carried over from previous session. 15/10/19: The bill, having been brought from the Commons, was, pursuant to resolution of 9/9/19, deemed to have been read a first and second time. 29/10/19: Bill committed to Select Committee. 30/10/19: Select Committee appointed.
Historical Institutional Abuse (Northern Ireland) Bill [HL]	30/10/19: Lord Hain successfully moved a manuscript amendment to a Business of the House motion on the Northern Ireland Budget Bill. As a result SO 40(4) and (5) was dispensed with to enable the Bill to have precedence over other business on 31/10/19 and SO 46 was dispensed with to allow the Bill to be taken through its remaining stages that day.
Northern Ireland Budget Bill	30/10/19: SO 40(4) and (5) dispensed with on 31/10/19 to enable the Bill to have precedence over other business that day; SO 46 dispensed with to allow the Bill to be taken through its remaining stages that day. Motion amended to include the Historical Institutional Abuse (Northern Ireland) Bill [HL], see above.
Sentencing (Pre-consolidation Amendments) Bill [HL] – Law Commission Bill	Carried over from previous session. 16/10/19: Pursuant to resolution of 5/9/19, SO 46 dispensed with to enable the bill to be taken pro forma through the stages which it had completed in the previous session. The bill was then read a second time, committed and reported from a Special Public Bill Committee, and the report received pro forma.
Private Members' Bills	66 Bills were drawn in the ballot but only 40 were introduced.
