

Follow in the footsteps of the Monarch at the State Opening of Parliament. From the Robing Room, proceed through the Royal Gallery and into the stunning Chamber of the House of Lords.

Look up in Central Lobby at the magnificent vaulted ceiling, then enter the intriguing rooms of the House of Commons. You can stand in the Chamber itself; home to the Speaker's Chair, the green benches and some lively political debates.

In St Stephen's Hall, discover how the suffragettes and other 'Votes for Women!' campaigners inspired the beautiful contemporary light sculpture *New Dawn*.

Finish in medieval Westminster Hall, the place where Guy Fawkes and King Charles I were found guilty of treason, and Nelson Mandela addressed both Houses of Parliament.

Follow your tour with a delicious afternoon tea served in a room overlooking the River Thames.



Big Ben and the Elizabeth Tower

The Elizabeth Tower is currently closed for extensive conservation work which is due for completion in 2021. Tours inside the Elizabeth Tower will then resume.

Eating and shopping

The Jubilee Café offers a selection of light meals and hot and cold drinks.

The Jubilee Shop is located off Westminster Hall. The Houses of Parliament Shop is located on the corner of Parliament Square. Both shops stock a range of gifts and souvenirs.

Watching debates and committees

This is free of charge on a first come, first served basis. Please check sitting times as these can vary from week to week.



Tour days

Advance booking is recommended but not always necessary.
